

## **PRIVACY POLICY**

Thank you for visiting my web site. Please be assured I recognize the importance of protecting the personal privacy of individuals using the Internet.

This web site collects no personal information about you when you visit unless you choose to provide that information via e-mail so that I may contact you about an issue or provide assistance.

### **Information Collected and Stored Automatically**

The U.S. House of Representatives collects aggregate data about visits to the U.S. House of Representatives web sites, such as statistics that show which parts of each web site were visited the most. The following information is also collected when you visit any U.S. House of Representatives web site:

- The name of the domain from which you access the Internet (for example, aol.com, if you are connecting from an America Online account).
- The date and time you access our site.
- The Internet address of the web site from which you linked directly to our site or the Internet address of the computer used to link to our site.

This information is used for site management purposes. This government computer system uses software programs to create summary statistics using this information. These statistics are used for such purposes as assessing the number of visitors to the different sections of our site, what information is of most and least interest, determining technical design specifications, and identifying system performance or problem areas.

**Remember, unless you choose to provide such information, we do not collect or maintain personal information about you when you visit our site.**

I do not track what you, as an individual, view. I have no way of obtaining your name or e-mail address unless you provide it.

### **If You Send an E-mail**

My web site does not collect any personal information about you when you visit the site unless you choose to provide that information via e-mail. If you choose to send me a message, I ask that you provide your name, address, e-mail address, and if you wish, your home or work telephone numbers. This information will be available to members of my staff so they can help me in responding to your message or request. I may also use the information from time to time to share updated information about Congressional issues with you. You may ask to stop receiving these updates at any point.

My office will share no personal information communicated through my web site with any outside organization or individual for purposes unrelated to my official duties except when needed to perform constituent casework at your request and with your permission, or in the course of an authorized law enforcement investigation or emergency posing an imminent risk to public safety.

### **Links to Other Sites**

My web site has links to other useful sites on the Internet, including sites of other government agencies and sites relating to Iowa. When you use a link on this web site to go to another web site, my privacy policy no longer applies. If you wish to know the privacy policy of a linked site you, will need to contact the webmaster of that site.

### **Use of Information**

Information presented on the site is considered public information and may be distributed or copied for non-commercial purposes. Use of appropriate photo/image credits is requested.

Unauthorized attempts to upload information or change information on this web-site are strictly prohibited and may be punishable under the Computer Fraud and Abuse Act of 1986, the National Information Infrastructure Protection Act and other applicable laws.
